- supervising and mentoring direct and indirect reports to assure performance and progress on assigned projects as appropriate

- making the regulatory decisions, represent the Company during the meetings with the regulatory agencies
- ensuring that the PV system is implemented properly and the risk-benefit ratio of the product remains positive
- approving major decisions during non-clinical and clinical development, especially related to study objectives, subjects safety and data integrity
- managing the medical monitoring, making the final decisions and acting as the Medical Monitor deputy when required
- communication with external parties, including PR and regulatory activities, on behalf of the Company
- ensuring that the Clinical and Medical Departments have sufficient resources and meet their objectives
